

Lesson 4. "Wait for God's Time"

This year we have been talking about choices and we have played some games that require us to make choices. Today we will learn from an important choice that David made when he met up with King Saul.

Once again, King Saul wanted to kill David. Why? David had done nothing wrong. In fact, he had risked his life when he killed Goliath and helped Israel defeat the Philistines. But Saul was jealous, and fearful that his son Jonathan would not be king after him.

David and his men were hiding in a cave, when Saul came into the same cave. David's men told David to kill Saul.

What are David's choices?

- a) Stop hiding from Saul, kill him, and take over as king
- b) Acknowledge that Saul was king by God's choice. Choose not to repay Saul's evil with evil. Show mercy to Saul.

What would the consequences be if David chose option A?

What would the consequences be if David chose option B?

Ultimately, what choice did David make?
