greatest commandment in the Law?"

<sup>37</sup> Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and

with all your mind.<sup>(a) 38</sup> This is the first and greatest commandment. <sup>39</sup> And the second is

like it: 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'<sup>[b] 40</sup> All the Law and the Prophets hang on these

two commandments."

## Let's look at the first command . "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.'

Jesus was saying that if we put God first, everything else will naturally follow. If we truly love God with all that we have, we would want to follow the other Laws, because we genuinely love Him. So how can we love God with all that we have? When we make decisions or do anything, we can do it with the fact of His presence in mind, and recall that He is always with us, watching, guiding and loving us. Acknowledge God is the creator and controls all things. We can show God our love through worship (singing glory and praises to Him, ), talking to Him (praying ), obeying Him, studying His word (with friends / family or by ourselves) and doing things that pleases Him.



Now the second commandment Jesus gave is 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'

Who is our *neighbour*? They are not just people we like or know or people next door to us. Our neighbours are all the people God created. We love them by showing kindness and respect and remembering that Jesus loves them and died for them too!

We don't always see that care and love demonstrated in people around us today do we? But, we can make a difference when we show God's love by sharing it. We can look for ways to be considerate and loving to those around us every day!
