## Please find below the instructions to the activity:

Step 1: Cut carefully around the alphabet letters; you may ask mum and or dad to assist you with the difficult corners.

Step 2: Colour and decorate the alphabet letters any way you like. You may need to wait till they dry if you used paint or glitter.

Step 3. Decorate Barnabus and Paul.

Step 4: Once you have everything, try and fit the word <u>Encourager</u> (that is what Barnabas was) of the paper. Then place Barnabus to the bottom <u>left side</u> of the A3 paper and Paul to the <u>upper</u> <u>middle</u> side of the paper.

Step 5: Given that Barnabus and Paul travelled together to spread the "Good News" about Jesus, use the arrow to link Barnabus and Paul together.
